An Act of the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands to appropriate certain sums of money out of the Cook Islands Government Account to the services of the Financial Year ending with the thirty first day of March 1976, and to amend the Appropriation Act 1975

8 March 1976

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN, - We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this year, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it be enacted: And be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Amendment Act 1976 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Appropriation Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").
2. Grant and Appropriation - Subsection (1) of section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the amount \$10,241,184 and substituting the amount of \$11,138,487.
3. Schedule - The principal Act is hereby further amended by omitting the Schedule and substituting the following Schedule:
