An Act of the Parliament of the Cook Islands to appropriate certain sums of money out of the Cook Islands Government Account to the services of the year ending with the thirtieth day of June 1996 and to appropriate the supplies granted in this period

(28 June 1996)

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN - We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Parliament of the Cook Islands, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this year, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech your Majesty that it may be enacted. And be it enacted by the Parliament of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and application - This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Amendment Act 1995-96, and applies to the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1996 (hereinafter referred to as "the year").
2. Grant and appropriation out of the Cook Islands Government Account - Subsection 1 of section 2 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the amount of \$67,638,900 and substituting the amount of \$60,930,400.
3. Schedule - The principal Act is hereby further amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following Schedule.
