REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>Short Title</u> This order may be cited as the Customs Ports of Entry (Manihiki) Order 1993.
- 2. <u>Interpretation</u> In this Order "Territorial Sea" means the territorial sea of the Cook Islands as described in section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977.
- 3. <u>Ports of entry declared</u> The ports mentioned in the schedule hereto are hereby declared to be ports of entry for the purposes of the Customs Act 1913, and the limits of the ports shall be those specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PORTS OF ENTRY

Name	Limits
Tauhunu (Island of Manihiki)	All that portion of the territorial sea within a circle having a radius of 1 nautical mile from the position LAT 10° 25.3 S. LONG 161° 03.0 W.
Tukao (Island of Manihiki)	All that portion of the territorial sea within a circle having a radius of 1 nautical mile from the position LAT 10° 22.4 S. LONG 161° 01.5 W.
