PURSUANT to the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the High Commissioner, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ANALYSIS

1. Title and commencement 2. Port of entry declared Schedule

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Port of Entry Order 1972.

 (2) This order shall come into force on the day after its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Fort of entry declared The port mentioned in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a port of entry for the purposes of the Customs Act 1913, and the limits of the port shall be those specified in the schedule.

SCHEDULE

Arutanga (Island of Aitutaki)

All that portion of land and sea comprised within an area commencing from the Post Office at Arutanga thence in right lines north 40 chains thence west 80 chains south 60 chains thence east 80 chains and thence 20 chains to the point of commencement.
