PURSUANT to section 11(2) of the Sale of Liquor Act 1991-92, His Excellency the Queen's Representative, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>Short Title</u> These Regulations may be cited as the Sale of Liquor (Airport Licences) Regulations 1993.
- 2. <u>Airport Duty Free Licences</u> (1) There is hereby established a kind of licence to be called an Airport Licence.
- (2) An Airport Licence shall authorise the holder of the licence to sell and supply liquor from premises within the arrival and departure transit area at the Rarotonga International Airport, to bona fide passengers and crew arriving at and departing from the airport on an international flight.

Cook Islands Laws

(3) An Airport Licence may authorise the sale or supply of liquor on any day at any time when an international air service is due to arrive at or depart from Rarotonga International Airport.
