## JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

After debating the matter with the Court the position was reached where the Counsel for the Respondent was prepared to consent to certain orders. As a consequence the Court Orders by consent.

- 1. The appeal is allowed
- 2. The Winding Up order in the High Court is set aside.

On the issue of costs, however, there was no agreement. The Court has a clear view on costs and Orders as follows:

- (i) On the Winding Up Petition in the High Court each party shall bear its own costs.
- (ii) On the application before Madam Justice Shameem the Appellant company shall have costs of \$150.
