RULING IN CHAMBERS

[1] The solicitors for the appellant have filed a notice of discontinuance with no order for cost on 17 April 2025.

[2] This relates to an *ex-parte* summons by the appellant for stay of the judgment of the Master of the High Court and a restraining order on the respondent from executing the said judgment


pending appeal. However, this court so far has not made the summons *inter parte* and as a result the respondent has not been served with the notice of appeal and the summons for the said orders.

- [3] Ms. M. Chowdhury informed court that the reason for the appeal to be discontinued is that the appeal should have been filed in the High Court.
