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**KEYWORDS:** Dismissal arising out of employment; Section 211 Employment Relations Act 2007; Negligence of employee; Striking out of proceedings for failing to take a step.

This matter was referred to the Tribunal on 19 January 2017 from the Mediation Service. The matter was heard on 5 April 2017. The Grievor was to file closing submissions by 17 May 2017. On 23 August 2017, the matter was called back on before the Tribunal and Directions issued to the Grievor to file submissions as to why leave should be granted to enlarge the time for the filing.
