CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI (Section 92(3))

MINISTERIAL ASSIGNMENT

To: Rear Admiral (Retired) Josaia Voreqe Bainimarama Prime Minister, and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I assigned to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister, and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry with effect from 24 September 2014, the responsibility for the conduct of Government business, departments and written laws specified in Legal Notice No. 43 of 2014;

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I assigned to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister, and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry with effect from 11 May 2015, the responsibility for the conduct of Government business, departments and written laws specified in Legal Notice No. 44 of 2015;

Now Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 1 August 2016, all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No. 44 of 2015, and with effect from the same day assign to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister, and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry, the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government business, divisions and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law)—
