FIJIAN COMPETITION AND CONSUMER COMMISSION ACT 2010

**Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission
(Control of Prices for Reinforcement Steel Rods)
Order 2021**

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 39 of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission Act 2010 and on the recommendation of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission, I hereby make this Order—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission (Control of Prices for Reinforcement Steel Rods) Order 2021.

(2) This Order comes into force on 14 November 2021.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, “market” means the sale and purchase of reinforcement steel rods through wholesale in Fiji.

Control of prices for steel rods

3. For the purpose of section 39 of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission Act 2010, the prices for reinforcement steel rods (in all qualities and classes) that are sold in the market are controlled including, but not limited to the following grades—

- (a) grade 300 deformed;
- (b) grade 300 plain;
- (c) grade 430 deformed;
- (d) grade 430 plain;
- (e) grade 500 deformed; and
- (f) grade 500 plain.

Expiration of Order

4. This Order expires at the start of 14 November 2024 unless it is varied, extended or revoked.
