## KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE DOGS REGULATION 1923.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty George the Figure by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Dogs (Amendment | R. at | 1000 mm. lation 1925, and shall be read and construed with the Dogs Room lation 1923 hereinafter called the Principal Regulation.

2. Section twelve of the principal Regulation is hereby amended ANIMOMENT CO.

and shall be read as if after the word "shillings" in the sixth line thereof the words "unless the owner be an aboriginal native of any island in the Protectorate when the sum shall be two shillings and sixpence" were inserted.

3. Section seventeen of the principal Regulation is hereby Augspurgent amended and shall be read as if after the last word thereof steres in "receipt" the following proviso were added thereto-

"provided that if the new owner be a non-native who has "acquired ownership of such dog from a native an additional

"fee of two shillings and sixpence shall be payable."

4. Section twenty-seven of the principal Regulation is hereby automates amended by the addition thereto at the end thereof of the following words:—"Similarly a further number of dogs may be so registered in respect of any such town provided that such further number shall not exceed the proportion of one dog for every fifty inhabitants of such town."

AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 8.

5. Schedule B of the principal Regulation is hereby amended by striking out the words "five shillings" and the figures 0.5.0 where they occur in the said Schedule.


COMMENCEMENT OF RECULATION. 6. This Regulation shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1926.
