KING'S REGULATION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE FEES TO BE TAKEN IN THE PRO-
TECTORATES OF THE BRITISH SOLOMON ISLANDS
AND THE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS IN CON-
NECTION WITH THE REGISTRATION OF DEEDS.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's Acting High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific in accordance with the provisions of the Pacific
Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of
God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and
of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of
the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Solomons and Gilbert and Ellice (Registration Fees) Regulation 1915. Short title.

2. "The Resident Commissioner" means the Resident Commissioner of the Solomon Islands Protectorate or the Resident Commissioner of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorate. Interpretation

3. It shall be lawful for the Resident Commissioner to demand and receive the several fees specified in the Schedule hereto for the performance of the several acts matters and things therein specified relating to the registers kept in his office of deeds and other documents concerning land. Power to Resident Commissioner to take fees.
