## Rules 30th August 1915 SECTION 25—SUPREME COURT (NOTARIAL ACTS ABROAD) RULES

## Made by the Chief Justice

1. These Rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Notarial Acts Abroad)
Rules.

2. All notarial acts may be done before Ambassador Envoy, etc.

2. All notarial acts which any notary public can do within Fiji and all examinations, affidavits, declarations, affirmations and attestations of honour in auses or matters depending in the Supreme Court may be sworn, taken, commissioner, Envoy, Minister, Charge d'Affaires, or Secretary of Embassy or Consul-General, Consul, Vice-Consul, Acting Consul, Pro-Consul or Consular General, Consul, Vice-Consul, Acting Consul, Pro-Consul or Consular General Supreme Court shall take judicial notice of the seal or signature as any such notarial act, examination, affidavit, declaration, affirmation or honour, or to any other deed or document.
