AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 7-96, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-126, 8-4 and 8-8, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Law No. 7-126, for the purpose of modifying the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 7-96, as amended by Public Law No.

2	7-126, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 1. Elementary and secondary education needs in Chuuk. The sum
4	of \$900,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
5	appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
6	for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, for the purpose of
7	funding elementary and secondary education needs in Chuuk State. The
