**PUBLIC LAW NO. 10-139**

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AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-119, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-124, 10-128, 10-130 and 10-132, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Law No. 10-132, to appropriate the sum of \$767,565 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, as supplemental funding for executive branch operations and programs, and to reallocate funds therein; and by further amending section 11, as amended by Public Law No. 10-130, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein for Rural Development in Kosrae; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 10-119, as amended by Public Law No. 10-132, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.  
The sum of \$13,682,571, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for the operations of the Executive Branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1999. Of the total funds appropriated under this section, \$519,000 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact of Free Association and \$84,595 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 214(b) of the Compact of

Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

Section 2. Section 11 of Public Law No. 10-119, as amended by Public Law No. 10-130, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 11. Other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds. The sum of \$4,505,184, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during

fiscal year 1999. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

Section 3. Section 15 of Public Law No. 10-119 notwithstanding, no funds appropriated by this act may be reprogrammed to any other numbered subsection or lettered paragraph within section 1 of said Public Law.

Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
