To amend Section 3 of Public Law No. 7-157, as amended by Public Law No. 1-32, relating to the Joint Coordinating Committee on Capital Relocation, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 7-157, as amended by Public
2	Law No. 1-132, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 3. Selection of Members and Tenure.
4	(1) Members of the Coordinating Committee are:
5	(a) The representative of the President of the
6	Federated States of Micronesia;
7	(b) The Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia, or his designee;
9	(c) The Administrators of the Departments of
10	Administrative Services, Community Services and Development
11	Services, or their designees;
12	(d) The Chairman of the Transition Committee of
13	the Commission on Future Political Status and Transition,
14	or his designee;
15	(e) A traditional leader from the State of Ponape
16	chosen by the traditional leaders of that State from among
17	their membership;
18	(f) A member of the Ponape State Legislature
19	chosen by the Speaker of the Legislature;
20	(g) A member appointed by the Governor of the
21	State of Ponape; and
22	(h) The traditional chief of Sokeha Mumicipality
