

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-119, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-132 and 10-139, for the purpose of allowing payment of additional overtime from funds previously appropriated and to appropriate \$17,065 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for National Police overtime, notwithstanding section 509 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 10-119, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-132 and 10-139, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The sum of \$13,699,636, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for the operations of the Executive Branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1999. Of the total funds appropriated under this section, \$519,000 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact of Free Association and \$84,595 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 214(b) of the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
