

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 13-36, as amended, by amending the title and sections 4 and 5, to change the use of certain funds, to repeal certain appropriations specified therein, to create a fund entitled "Public Projects for Chuuk Election District No. 5" within the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 13-36, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 13-49 and 13-66, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4           "An act to appropriate the sum of \$2,560,000, from the  
5 local revenue in the General Fund of the Federated  
6 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
7 September 30, 2004, for the purpose of funding social  
8 and economic development projects in the states, and for  
9 other purposes."

10          Section 2. Section 4 of Public Law No. 13-36, as amended by  
11 Public Laws Nos. 13-49 and 13-66, is hereby further amended to  
12 read as follows:

13          "Section 4. The sum of \$960,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
15 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
16 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide  
17 funding for social and economic development projects in

1 the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this  
2 section shall be apportioned as follows:

16 Section 3. All funds deleted from subsection 4(1)(e) of  
17 Public Law No. 13-36, as amended, by the amendments herein shall  
18 be placed in a fund entitled "Public Projects for Chuuk Election  
19 District No. 5" that is hereby created within the General Fund.

20 Section 4. Section 5 of Public Law No. 13-36, as amended by  
21 Public Laws Nos. 13-49 and 13-66, is hereby further amended to  
22 read as follows:

23 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
24 date.

25 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,

1 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance  
2 with applicable law, including but not limited to, the  
3 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the  
4 funds appropriated under sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act  
5 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
6 Micronesia or his designee, except that the allottee of  
7 the funds appropriated under subsections 1(1), 1(3) and  
8 1(4) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of  
9 Kosrae; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
10 sections 2(3) and 2(4) of this act shall be the Governor  
11 of the State of Yap; the allottee of the funds  
12 appropriated under sections 2(5), 2(6), and 2(7) shall  
13 be the Speaker of Congress; the allottee of the funds  
14 appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(i) shall be the  
15 mayor of Kolonia Town; the allottee of the funds  
16 appropriated under subsections 3(2)(a)(ii), 3(2)(a)(iv)  
17 and 3(2)(a)(v) shall be the Sokehs magistrate; the  
18 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
19 3(2)(a)(iii) shall be the mayor of Nukuoro; and the  
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
21 3(2)(c)(v) and 3(2)(c)(vi) shall be the Pohnpei  
22 Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds  
23 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the  
24 Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects, except  
25 that the funds appropriated under section 4(1)(c) of

1           this act shall be allotted to the President of the  
2           Federated States of Micronesia.

3           (2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein  
4           shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or  
5           so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for  
6           the purpose specified herein, and shall report back to  
7           the Congress on the status of these funds no later than  
8           September 30, 2005. The authority of the allottees to  
9           obligate such funds shall not lapse until fully  
10          expended."

11          Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
12          President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
13          becoming law without such approval.
