

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 13-46, as amended, by amending sections 2, 3, 5, 6, 8 and 9 thereof for the purpose of appropriating an additional sum of \$1,134,150 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 13-62 and 13-81, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4           "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.

5           The sum of \$13,752,322, or so much thereof as may be  
6           necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
8           year ending September 30, 2005, for the operations of  
9           the Executive Branch of the National Government during  
10          fiscal year 2005. The sum appropriated by this section  
11          shall be apportioned as follows:

12                 (1) Office of the President

13                 \$700,864, for the activities set forth in the  
14                 performance budget pages 1 through 2 of the budget book.  
15                 Of the funds appropriated, \$35,000 shall be deemed to  
16                 come from carryover funds available under section  
17                 215(a)(2) of Compact I for communications.

18                 (2) Department of Foreign Affairs

1           \$3,426,792 for the activities set forth in the  
2           performance budget pages 20 through 24 of the budget  
3           book, provided that \$29,000, or so much thereof as may  
4           be necessary, is to be used to provide housing  
5           allowances to consular staff in Honolulu and,  
6           notwithstanding any other section of Public Law No. 13-  
7           46, shall not be reprogrammed or used for any other  
8           purpose. Of the amount appropriated, \$141,800 shall be  
9           deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
10          section 215(a)(2) of Compact I for communications.

11          (3) Department of Finance and Administration  
12          \$2,439,532 for the activities set forth in the  
13          performance budget pages 73 through 77 of the budget  
14          book, provided that \$100,000 of this amount shall be  
15          used to fund a portion of the deficit recorded by the  
16          National Government at the close of fiscal year 2003  
17          (which funds have been reprogrammed for disaster relief  
18          under the President's emergency powers). Of the total  
19          funds appropriated, \$46,914 shall be deemed to come from  
20          carryover funds available under section 215(a)(2) of  
21          Compact I for communications.

22          (4) Department of Economic Affairs  
23          \$1,071,353, for the activities set forth in the  
24          performance budget pages 126 through 132 of the budget  
25          book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$29,381 shall be

1           deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
2           section 215(a)(2) of Compact I for communications.

3           (5) Department of Transportation, Communication and  
4           Infrastructure  
5           \$1,264,922 for the activities set forth in the  
6           performance budget pages 183 through 185 of the budget  
7           book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$20,000 shall be  
8           deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
9           section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

10          (6) Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs  
11          \$1,526,808, for a portion of the activities set forth in  
12          the performance budget pages 210 through 216 of the  
13          budget book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$50,000  
14          shall be deemed to come from carryover funds available  
15          under section 216(a)(2) of Compact I for Health,  
16          \$475,200 shall be deemed to come from funds available  
17          under the education sector of the Amended Compact,  
18          \$763,234 from the health sector, and \$111,421 from the  
19          environment sector.

20          (7) Department of Justice  
21          \$2,544,538 for the activities set forth in the  
22          performance budget pages 339 through 342 of the budget  
23          book provided that no more than \$31,000 of this amount  
24          may be expended on fuel oil for National Police Patrol  
25          boats until the Department has submitted to Congress an

1 accounting concerning the use of fuel oil for this  
2 purpose in fiscal year 2004, including a description of  
3 each trip taken and the amount and cost of fuel used for  
4 each trip. Of the total funds appropriated, \$37,000  
5 shall be deemed to come from carryover funds available  
6 under section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications,  
7 \$48,480 from carryover funds available under section  
8 216(a)(1) of Compact I for Maritime Surveillance, and  
9 \$47,486 from carryover funds available under 216(b) of  
10 Compact I for Marine Surveillance.

11 (8) FSM Public Defender Office

12 \$677,513 for the activities set forth in the performance  
13 budget pages 372 through 373 of the budget book,  
14 provided that \$16,000, or so much thereof as may be  
15 necessary, is to be used for payment of the professional  
16 premium to any eligible person or persons, and  
17 notwithstanding any other section of Public Law No. 13-  
18 46, shall not be reprogrammed or used for any other  
19 purpose. Of the total funds appropriated, \$9,800 shall  
20 be deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
21 section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

22 (9) Office of Compact Management

23 \$100,000 to fund the establishment and operations of an  
24 Office of Compact Management in accordance with Public  
25 Law No. 13-75, provided that these funds shall not be

1           used to meet the cost of activities that are already  
2           being undertaken within the National Government."

3           Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
4 Public Laws Nos. 13-62 and 13-81, is hereby further amended to read  
5 as follows:

6           "Section 3. Operating expenses of the Legislative  
7 Branch. The sum of \$3,343,077, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
9 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
10 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, for the  
11 operations of the Legislative Branch of the National  
12 Government during the fiscal year ending September 30,  
13 2005, for the operations of the Legislative Branch of  
14 the National Government during fiscal year 2005, in  
15 order to achieve the activities set forth in the  
16 performance budget pages 380 through 381 of the budget  
17 book. Of the funds appropriated, \$40,000 shall be  
18 deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
19 section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications."

20          Section 3. Section 5 of the Public Law No. 13-46, as amended  
21 by Public Law No. 13-81, is hereby further amended to read as  
22 follows:

23          "Section 5. Operating expenses of the Public Auditor  
24 Office.

25          The sum of \$670,028, or so much thereof as may be

1           necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
2           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
3           year ending September 30, 2005, for the operations of  
4           the Office of the FSM Public Auditor during fiscal year  
5           2005 in order to achieve the activities set forth in the  
6           performance budget page 417 of the budget book. All  
7           funds appropriated herein shall be deemed to come from  
8           funds available under the capacity building sector of  
9           the Amended Compact, except that \$112,000 shall be  
10          funded from domestic revenues, of which \$107,000 shall  
11          be applied to the cost of the annual Single Audit and  
12          \$5,000 for representation."

13          Section 4. section 6 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
14          Public Law No. 13-62, is hereby further amended to read as  
15          follows:

16                 "Section 6. Operating Expenses of agencies of the  
17                 National Government.

18                 The sum of \$1,443,340, or so much thereof as may be  
19                 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
20                 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
21                 year ending September 30, 2005, for the operations of  
22                 the following boards, commissions and agencies during  
23                 fiscal year 2005. The sum appropriated by this section  
24                 shall be apportioned as follows:

- 25                         (1) National Oceanic Resources Management Authority

1           \$397,357, for the activities set forth in the  
2           performance budget pages 425 through 427 of the budget  
3           book. Of the funds appropriated, \$21,000 shall be  
4           deemed to come from\_carryover funds available under  
5           section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

6           (2) Board of Regents - COM-FSM

7           \$84,460, for the activities set forth in the performance  
8           pages 435 through 436 of the budget book.

9           (3) FSM Coconut Development Authority

10          \$109,346, for the activities set forth in the  
11          performance budget pages 440 through 441 of the budget  
12          book. Of the funds appropriated, \$3,500 shall be deemed  
13          to come from carryover funds available under section  
14          215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

15          (4) FSM Banking Board

16          \$138,388, for the activities set forth in the  
17          performance budget pages 447 through 448 of the budget  
18          book. Of the funds appropriated, \$7,000 shall be deemed  
19          to come from carryover funds available under section  
20          215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

21          (5) FSM Postal Services

22          \$613,789, for the activities set forth in the  
23          performance budget pages 454 through 456 of the budget  
24          book. Of the funds appropriated, \$22,000 shall be  
25          deemed to come from carryover funds available under

1 section 215(b)(2) of Compact I for communications.

2 (6) FSM National Fisheries Corporation.

3 \$100,000 for the activities set forth in the performance  
4 budget page 463 of the budget book."

5 Section 5. Section 8 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
6 Public Law No. 13-81, is hereby further amended to read as  
7 follows:

8 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

9 The sum of \$2,755,103, or so much thereof as may be  
10 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
11 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
12 year ending September 30, 2005, for the following  
13 grants, subsidies and contributions during fiscal year  
14 2005. The sum appropriated by this section shall be  
15 apportioned as follows:

6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
8 year ending September 30, 2005, for the following  
9 capital improvement, development programs and projects  
10 and human resource development. The sum appropriated  
11 under this section shall be apportioned as follows:

12 (1) College of Micronesia-FSM

13 (a) Operations of the College of Micronesia-FSM,  
14 including planning, construction and maintenance of  
15 college facilities. All funds appropriated herein shall  
16 be deemed to come from funds available under the  
17 education sector of the Amended Compact ..\$ 3,856,067

19 and housing, COM-FSM, provided that all  
20 of the funds appropriated herein shall  
21 be deemed to come from carryover funds  
22 available under section 216(a)(3) of
