

AN ACT

To appropriate \$1,400,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the States of Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Shall read as follows: To appropriate the sum of
2 \$1,400,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for the
4 purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the
5 States of Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei and Kosrae; and for other purposes.

6 The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

13 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

14 (1) General Provisions.

15 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
17 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
18 Management Act of 1979 and the amended Compact of Free Association
19 between the United States Government and the Government of the
20 Federated States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

21 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
22 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
23 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,
24 and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
25 appropriated.

1 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated
2 by this act are as follows:

3 (a) Subsection 1 of Section 1 - the allottee of
4 these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia or his designee;

6 (b) Subsection 2 of Section 1 - the allottee of
7 these funds shall be the Governor of Yap State or his designee;

8 (c) Subsection 3 of Section 1 - the allottee of
9 these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia;

11 (d) Subsection 4 of Section 1 - the allottee of
12 these funds shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement
13 Projects;

14 Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to obligate
15 funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse until fully
16 expended.

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25 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
2 becoming law without such approval.
