PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-68

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending the title and sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Pohnpei, and Chuuk and to offer technical amendments thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 16-49 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 “To appropriate the sum of \$2,195,000 from the General
4 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose
6 of funding public projects and social programs in the
7 four States of the Federated States of Micronesia, and
8 for other purposes.”

9 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-49 is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 “Section 1. The sum of \$2,195,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the
15 purpose of funding public projects and social programs
16 in the four States of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia.”

18 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-49 is hereby

1 amended to read as follows:

2 "Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,195,000 appropriated by
3 this act, \$205,000 is apportioned for Kosrae State for
4 public projects and social programs.
