

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 8 and 12 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Law No. 17-28, to appropriate \$50,000 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and to change the use of funds previously appropriated for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
2 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
4 appropriate the sum of \$45,327,053, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
7 year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of
8 funding the operations of all branches of the
9 National Government of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
11 subsidies and contributions. Of the total amount of
12 funds appropriated herein, \$4,437,560 shall be
13 deemed to come from funds available under the
14 amended Compact from the education sector subject to
15 the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended
16 Compact; \$1,176,656 shall be deemed to come from
17 funds available under the Supplemental Education
18 Grant; \$878,750 shall be deemed to come from funds

1 available under the amended Compact from the health
2 sector subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under
3 the amended Compact; \$329,598 shall be deemed to
4 come from funds available under the amended Compact
5 from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be
6 deemed to come from funds available under the
7 amended Compact from the private sector development
8 sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be deemed to come from
9 funds available under the amended Compact from the
10 infrastructure sector.

11 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
12 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

14 The sum of \$9,526,230, or so much thereof as may be
15 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
16 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
17 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the
18 following grants, subsidies and contributions during
19 fiscal year 2012. Of the total amount of funds
20 appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come
21 from funds available under the amended Compact from
22 the education sector; and \$-0- shall be deemed to
23 come from funds available under the Supplemental
24 Education Grant. The sum appropriated by this
25 section shall be apportioned as follows:

23 Section 3. Section 12 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
 24 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and

1 lapse dates.

2 (1) General provisions.

3 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall
4 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
5 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
6 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

7 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
8 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
10 specified in this act, and that no obligations are
11 incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

12 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
13 appropriated by this act are as follows:

14 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
15 shall be the President of the Federated States of
16 Micronesia;

17 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
18 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
19 States of Micronesia;

20 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
21 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of
22 the Federated States of Micronesia;

23 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
24 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States
25 of Micronesia;

1 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of
2 these funds shall be the President of the Federated States
3 of Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
4 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

5 (i) Section 8, subsection (13)(a)
6 through (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
7 Chief Justice of the respective State Supreme Court,

8 (ii) Section 8, subsection 13(r) - the
9 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the State
10 of Yap,

11 (iii) Section 9(1)(a) - the allottee of
12 these funds shall be the President of the College of
13 Micronesia-FSM.

14 (iv) Section 9, subsection (12)(a)
15 through (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
16 Chief Justice of the FSM Supreme Court.

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1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
