

AN ACT

To further amend section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-55, 11-65, 11-78, 12-3, 12-25, 12-72, 15-56, 15-68 and 17-58, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 11-55, 11-65, 11-78, 12-3, 12-25, 12-72,
3 15-56, 15-68 and 17-58, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 3. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
7 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
9 2000, for the purpose of funding infrastructure
10 projects, roads, and other economic and social
11 projects and programs in the State of Yap. The funds
12 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned
13 as follows:
