AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 12 of Public Law No. 17-64 in order to appropriate \$2,253,200 in supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013; to align the budget act with Amended Compact Grant awards and Supplemental Education Grant award; to assign an allottee; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-64 is hereby

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
4 appropriate the sum of \$42,489,854, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the  
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
7 ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding  
8 the operations of all branches of the National  
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
11 contributions, and Capital and Human Resources  
12 Development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated  
13 herein, \$4,252,868 shall be deemed to come from funds  
14 available under the amended Compact from the education  
15 sector subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the  
16 amended Compact; \$1,168,765 shall be deemed to come from  
17 funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant;  
18 \$895,705 shall be deemed to come from funds available

1 under the amended Compact from the health sector subject to  
2 the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;  
3 \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under  
4 the amended Compact from the capacity building sector;  
5 \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under  
6 the amended Compact from the private sector development  
7 sector; \$222,450 shall be deemed to come from funds  
8 available under the amended Compact from the enhanced  
9 reporting and accountability sector; and \$1,153,025  
10 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
11 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector."

12 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 17-64 is hereby  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.  
15 The sum of \$18,346,251, or so much thereof as may be  
16 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
17 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
18 year ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of  
19 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the  
20 National Government during fiscal year 2013. Of the  
21 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$652,868  
22 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
23 amended Compact from the education sector subject to the  
24 receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;  
25 \$485,419 shall be deemed to come from funds available

1           under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$505,705 shall  
 2           be deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
 3           Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of  
 4           Grant Awards under the amended Compact; and \$-0- shall  
 5           be deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
 6           Compact from the capacity building sector; \$157,450  
 7           shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
 8           amended Compact from the enhanced reporting and  
 9           accountability sector and \$1,153,025 shall be deemed to  
 10          come from funds available under the amended Compact from  
 11          the infrastructure sector. The sum appropriated by this  
 12          section shall be apportioned as follows:

6 "Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and  
7 lapse dates.

8 (1) General Provisions.

9 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall  
10 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for  
11 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

13 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
14 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may  
15 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes  
16 specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
17 incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

18 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
19 appropriated by this act are as follows:

20 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
21 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
22 Micronesia;

23 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
24 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
25 States of Micronesia;

1 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds  
2 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of  
3 the Federated States of Micronesia;

4 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
5 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States  
6 of Micronesia;

7 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of  
8 these funds shall be the President of the Federated  
9 States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the  
10 following subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this  
11 act:

12 (i) Section 8, subsection (13)(a) through  
13 (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief  
14 Justice of the respective State Supreme Court,

15 (ii) Section 9(1)(a) - the allottee of  
16 these funds shall be the President of the College of  
17 Micronesia-FSM.

18 (iii) Section 8, subsection (13)(u) - the  
19 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the  
20 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

21 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottees to  
22 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse  
23 as of September 30, 2013; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the  
24 funds appropriated under section 9 of this act shall  
25 not lapse."

1           Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
