**PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-98**

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 18-70 by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the States of Kosrae, Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-70 is hereby amended  
2 to read as follows:

21 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-70 is hereby  
22 amended to read as follows:

23 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
24 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
25 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in

1           accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
2           limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
3           allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
4           funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
5           solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
6           no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
7           appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
8           under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
9           State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under  
10          subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The  
11          allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of  
12          this act shall be the President of the Federated States  
13          of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the funds  
14          appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h,  
15          i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x and ag, ah and aj  
16          of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town  
17          Government or his designee and the funds appropriated  
18          under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f and g of section 4(1)  
19          and section 4(2)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
20          Transportation Authority. The allottee of funds  
21          appropriated under subsection 4(1)(h) shall be the  
22          President of the Federated States of Micronesia of his  
23          designee. The allottee of funds appropriate under  
24          subsection 4(2)(g) of this act shall be the  
25          Administrator of the MiCare program. The allottee of

1 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of  
2 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
3 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
4 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock  
5 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
6 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be  
7 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The  
8 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of  
9 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.  
10 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(6)  
11 of this act shall be the General Manager of the  
12 Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority  
13 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this  
14 act shall lapse on September 30, 2015."

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25 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
2 becoming law without such approval.
