

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 18-99, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Kosrae and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 18-99, is hereby
