PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-113

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Law No. 18-106, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 18-106, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
16 Public Law No. 18-106, is hereby further amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
19 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
20 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
21 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
22 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
23 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
24 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in
25 excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
2 Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
3 section 3 shall be the President or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the
4 allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d),
5 (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n) and (o) shall be
6 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The allottee of funds
7 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President or
8 his designee, EXCEPT that the allottee of funds appropriated under
9 section 4(1)(a) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
10 Education; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(c),
11 (e), and (h) shall be Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
12 Communications and Infrastructure; the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port
14 Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(f)
15 shall be the Nett District Government; the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under section 4(1)(g) shall be the Secretary of the
17 Department of Resources and Development; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under section 4(2)(b) shall be the Mayor of Kapinga
19 Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
20 section 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority and
21 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(g) shall be
22 the COM-FSM Cooperative Extension Service. The allottee of funds
23 appropriated under sections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the
24 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock

1 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
2 under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
3 Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
5 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(6)
6 of this act shall be the General Manager of the Northwest Island
7 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
8 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2015.

9 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
