

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113 and 18-121, by amending sections 4, 5, and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 18-113 and 18-121, is hereby amended to read as
3 follow:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated in this act,
5 \$800,000 is appropriated for public projects and social
6 programs for the people of the State of Pohnpei.

25 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by

1 Public Laws Nos. 18-113 and 18-121, is hereby further amended to
2 read as follows:

3 “Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
8 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
10 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
11 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
13 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
14 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
15 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or
16 his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e),
18 (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o) and (u)
19 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
20 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
21 act shall be the President or his designee, EXCEPT that
22 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a)
23 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education;
24 the allottee of funds appropriated under section
25 4(1)(c), (e), and (h) shall be Secretary of the

1 Department of Transportation, Communications and
2 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
3 section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the
4 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(f)
5 shall be the Nett District Government; the allottee of
6 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(g) shall be the
7 Secretary of the Department of Resources and
8 Development; the allottee of funds appropriated under
9 section 4(2)(b) shall be the Mayor of Kapinga Municipal
10 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 sections 4(3)(b) and 4(4)(a) shall be the Pohnpei
12 Transportation Authority and the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under section 4(3)(g) shall be the COM-FSM
14 Cooperative Extension Service. The allottee of funds
15 appropriated under sections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this
16 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
17 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
18 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
19 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
21 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
23 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
24 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
25 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
