3 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by  
4 Public Law No. 19-75, is hereby further amended to read as  
5 follows:

6 ``Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
7 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
8 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for  
9 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but  
10 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
11 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that  
12 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
13 are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
14 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
15 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds  
16 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the  
17 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds  
18 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall  
19 be the President of the Federated States of  
20 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the  
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
22 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j),  
23 (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s), (t),  
24 (u), (v), (ag), (ar) and (as) of this act shall be  
25 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee;

1 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
2 3(w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae),  
3 (af), (ah), (ai), (aj), (ak), (al), (am), (an), (ao),  
4 (ap) and (aq) of this act shall be the Mayor of  
5 Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the  
6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
7 4(1)(a), (b), (c), (e), (f), and 4(2) shall be the  
8 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
9 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;  
10 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
11 4(1)(d), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(l) shall be the  
12 Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA). The allottee  
13 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(w),  
14 4(4)(k) and 4(4)(j) shall be Pohnpei PUC. The  
15 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
16 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor  
17 of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of  
18 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
19 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.  
20 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
21 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
22 Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
23 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall  
24 be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority  
25 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by

1           this act shall lapse on September 30, 2017.''

2           Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
4 becoming law without such approval.
