PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-54

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42 by appropriating \$9,333,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to provide funding for the set-up and operations costs of a consulate on the West Coast of the United States, for the FSM Trust Fund, and for the Telecommunications cable project; to make a technical correction, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42 as hereby amended to read
2 as follows:

3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
4 appropriate the sum of \$77,236,100 from the General Fund
5 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
6 year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose of
7 funding the operations of all branches of the National
8 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
9 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
10 contributions and Capital and Human Resources
11 Development. The National Government's share of the
12 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT
13 THAT; the National Government will retain 10 percent of
14 the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected
15 in the budget for the Department of Education. The sum
16 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

17 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby
18 amended to read as follows:

1 “Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. The
2 sum of \$12,143,827, or so much thereof as may be
3 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
4 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
5 year ending September 30, 2018, for the following
6 grants, subsidies and contributions. The sum
7 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
8 follows:

1 Section 3. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

4 The sum of \$36,270,106, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
7 year ending September 30, 2018, for the following
8 capital improvements, development programs, and projects
9 and human resources development. Of the total amount of
10 funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to
11 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from
12 the Supplemental Education Grant and \$5,252,250 shall be
13 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended
14 Compact from Compact Sector Grants. The sum
15 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
16 follows:
