

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-45, 19-61, 19-83, 19-95 and 19-122, by amending sections 1 and 9 thereof, to deappropriate an amount of \$800,000 from the Capital and Human Resources Development for the state of Kosrae infrastructure priority projects funding, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-45, 19-61, 19-83 and 19-95, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as  
5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$74,629,823 from the  
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the  
8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the  
9 National Government of the Federated States of  
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human  
12 Resources Development. The National Government's share  
13 of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero  
14 except that the National Government will retain 10  
15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is  
16 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.  
17 The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as  
18 follows:

19           Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by

1 Public Laws Nos. 19-61, 19-83, 19-95 and 19-122, is hereby further  
 2 amended to read as follows:

3           "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

4           The sum of \$36,137,693, or so much thereof as may be  
 5           necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
 6           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
 7           year ending September 30, 2016, for the following  
 8           capital improvements, development programs, and projects  
 9           and human resources development. Of the total amount of  
 10          funds appropriated herein, \$2,050,546 shall be deemed to  
 11          come from funds available under the Amended Compact from  
 12          the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated  
 13          by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
