**PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-172**

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AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by Public Laws No. 20-154 and 20-159, in order to appropriate \$15,963,478 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide additional funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various grants, subsidies and contributions, and capital and human resources development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by  
2 Public Laws No. 20-154 and 20-159, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4           "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
5 appropriate the sum of \$83,924,389 from the General Fund  
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7 year ending September 30, 2019, for the purpose of  
8 funding the operations of all branches of the National  
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources  
12 Development. The National Government's share of the  
13 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT  
14 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact  
15 Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the  
16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in  
17 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum

1           appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

2           Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 20-154 and 20-159, is hereby further amended to  
4 read as follows:

5           "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.

6           The sum of \$23,202,156, or so much thereof as may be

7 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 20-131

8 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 “Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and  
10 Lapse Dates.

11 (1) General provisions.

12 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
13 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
14 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
15 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

16 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
17 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
18 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in  
19 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
20 of the sums appropriated.

21 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
22 appropriated by this act are as follows:

23 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
24 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
25 Micronesia;

1                   (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
2 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
3 States of Micronesia;

4                   (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds  
5 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
6 Federated States of Micronesia;

7                   (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
8 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of

12 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following  
13 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

15 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint  
16 Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

17                   (ii) Section 8(8)(c) - the allottee of these  
18 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

19                   (iii) Section 8(9) - the allottee of these  
20 funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the  
21 Federated States of Micronesia;

22                   (iv) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of  
23 these funds shall be the President of the College of  
24 Micronesia-FSM;

1                   (v) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the  
2 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of  
3 the respective State Supreme Court;

4                   (vi) Section 8(12)(g) - the allottee of  
5 these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on  
6 Compact Review and Planning;

7                   (vii) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these  
8 funds shall be the President of the College of  
9 Micronesia-FSM;

10                  (viii) Section 9(3)(g) - the allottee of these  
11 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

12                  (ix) Section 9(3)(h) - the allottee of these  
13 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

14                  (x) Section 9(3)(i) - the allottee of these  
15 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

16                  (xi) Section 9(3)(j) - the allottee of these  
17 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

18                  (xii) Section 9(14) - the allottee of these  
19 funds shall be Telecommunication Regulation Authority;

20                  (xiii) Section 9(15)(a)(1) - the allottee of  
21 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of  
22 Kosrae;

23                  (xiv) Section 9(15)(a)(2) - the allottee of  
24 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of  
25 Pohnpei;

1                   (xv) Section 9(15)(a)(3) – the allottee of  
2                   these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

3                   (xvi) Section 9(15)(a)(4) – the allottee of  
4                   these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

5                   (xvii) Section 9(15)(d) – the allottee of  
6                   these funds shall be the Governor of the state of  
7                   Pohnpei;

8                   (xviii) Section 9(15)(e)(1) and (3) – the  
9                   allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
10                  state of Chuuk;

11                  (xix) Section 9(15)(e)(2) – the allottee of  
12                  these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the  
13                  Federated States of Micronesia.

14                  (xx) Section 8(12)(y)(3) – the allottee of  
15                  these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk;

16                  (xxi) Section 8(12)(y)(4) – the allottee of  
17                  these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.

18                  (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to  
19                  obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
20                  of September 30, 2019; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds  
21                  appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not  
22                  lapse.”

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1           Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
