

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-178, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 therein, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated thereof, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-178 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under
4 this act, \$1,400,000 shall be apportioned for
5 public projects and social programs for the people
6 of Kosrae State.

16 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178 is hereby
17 amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
19 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
20 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
21 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
23 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
24 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
25 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

1 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
4 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
5 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
6 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT
7 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
8 3(ad) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM or
9 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
10 subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this act shall be the
11 Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The
12 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
13 act shall be the President of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee
15 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(q) of this
16 act shall be the President of COM-FSM or his designee;
17 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
18 4(1)(s) of this act shall be the Mayor of Madolenhimw
19 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
20 funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(t) of this act
21 shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his designee;
22 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
23 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the
24 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs
25 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated

1 under subsections 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(e) of this act shall
2 be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his
3 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(i) and
5 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
6 Department of Transportation, Communications and
7 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(k) of this act shall
9 be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and
10 Development or his designee; The allottee of the funds
11 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of
12 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
13 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
14 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
15 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the
16 funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
17 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
18 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
19 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
20 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
21 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
22 30, 2020.”

23 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
24 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
25 becoming law without such approval.
