## AN ACT

To further amend section 9 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-154, 20-159, 20-172, 20-187, 21-03, 21-10 and 21-38, in order to realign certain funds in order to secure funding for the purchase of real estate for the FSM Embassy in Japan, to fund the Yap subaccount of the FSM Trust Fund from funds previously appropriated for other uses, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-131, as
- 2 amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-154, 20-159, 20-172 and 20-187,
- 3 21-03, 21-10 and 21-38, is hereby further amended to read as
- follows:
