

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25, 20-58, 20-76, 20-116 and 21-29, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-96, 19-163,
3 20-03, and 20-76, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,800,000
5 appropriated by his act, \$1,200,000 is
6 apportioned for public projects and social
7 programs in the state of Chuuk.

23 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended
 24 by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-96, 20-25, 20-116,
 25 21-29 and 21-64, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

1 “Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
2 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
3 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
4 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
6 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
8 used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and
9 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
10 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
11 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
12 Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 2(h) of this act shall
14 be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds
15 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
16 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
17 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d),
19 (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) and (k) of this act shall
20 be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of
21 funds appropriated under subsection 3(y) of this act
22 shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or
23 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsections 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(h) shall be the Secretary
25 of the Department of Transportation, Communications

1 and Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated
2 under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of this
3 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; and
4 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
5 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
6 Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of
8 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
9 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
10 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
11 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
12 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall
13 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
15 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
16 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
17 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
18 September 30, 2022."
