## AN ACT

To further amend sections 2 and 3 of Public Law No. 4-93, Pohnpei State public projects, as amended by Public Law No. 4-107, for the purpose of allowing certain funds appropriated thereby to be used for Mokil municipal operations; extending the lapse date for all funds appropriated, except those appropriated under subsection 4(1) of section 2; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-93, as amended by Public Law No. 4-107, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 3 "Section 2. 15	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 4-93, as amended by Public
16	Law No. 4-107, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
19	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
20	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall
21	be the Governor of Pohnpei State for all the appropriations
22	herein, except that the Pohnpei Community Action Agency shall
23	be the allottee for appropriations under subsection (2) of
24	section 2, the Menin Keder Lapalap of the Madolenihmw
25	Municipal Government shall be the allottee for appropriations

under subsection (1)(a) of section 2, the Luhken Men	lap of the
Kitti Municipal Government shall be the allottee for	appro-
priations under subsection (1)(b) of section 2, the	Chief
Magistrate of Sokehs shall be the allottee for appro	priations
under subsection (3)(a) of section 2, the Kolonia To	wn Mayor
shall be the allottee for appropriations under subse	ction
(3)(b) of section 2, the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuahfik	shall be
the allottee for all appropriations under subsection	(3)(c)
of section 2, and the Pohnpei Farmers Home Administr	ation
Office shall be the allottee for appropriations unde	r
subsections $(1)(a)(xxix)$ , $(1)(b)(xxviii)$ , and $(4)(f)$	of
section 2. The allottees shall be responsible for e	nsuring
that these funds, or so much thereof as may be neces	sary, are
used solely for the purposes specified in this act,	and that
no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum app	ropriated.
The authority of the allottees to obligate all funds	appro-
priated by this act, except those appropriated under	sub-
section (4)(1) of section 2, shall lapse as of Septer	mber 30,
1988. The funds appropriated under subsection (4)(1	) of
section 2 shall not lapse."	

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval. John R. Haglelgam President Federated States of Micronesia
