FIFTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

SECOND SPECIAL SESSION, 1987

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 5-221, C.D.1,  
C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-29, and 5-30, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, and 5-30, to change the purpose of an appropriation for the Mortlocks from a leadership conference to typhoon relief, and by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 5-29, to change the allottee of funds appropriated under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) and paragraph (1) of subsection (5) of section 2, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by  
2       Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, and 5-30, is hereby further amended to  
3       read as follows:

8           Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by  
9    Public Law No. 5-29, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

10          "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
11          allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
12          accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
13          limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
14          Except for those funds appropriated under paragraph (a)  
15          of subsection (1) of section 2, paragraphs (a), (b), (c),  
16          and (d) of subsection (2) of section 2, subsection (5) of  
17          section 2 and paragraphs (a), (b), (c), and (d) of  
18          subsection (6) of section 2, the allottee shall be the  
19          Governor of the State of Truk. The allottee of funds  
20          appropriated under paragraph (a) of subsection (1)  
21          of section 2 shall be the Truk State Delegation to the  
22          Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. The  
23          allottee for funds appropriated under paragraphs (a),  
24          (b), (c), and (d) of subsection (2) of section 2 shall be  
25          the Northern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottees

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1           for funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 2  
2           shall be the respective development authorities of the  
3           Mortlock Islands, except for those funds appropriated under  
4           paragraph (1) of subsection (5) of section 2 for which the  
5           allottee shall be the Truk State Delegation to the Congress  
6           of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee for  
7           funds appropriated under paragraph (a) of subsection (6) of  
8           section 2 shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The  
9           allottee for funds appropriated under paragraph (b) of  
10          subsection (6) of section 2 shall be the Weito Development  
11          Authority. The allottee for funds appropriated under  
12          paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (6) of section 2 shall  
13          be the Hall Islands Development Authority. The allottees  
14          shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so  
15          much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the  
16          purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
17          incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority  
18          of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
19          shall remain effective until funds are fully expended. The  
20          allottees shall make a written report of the status of the  
21          funds appropriated hereunder to the Congress of the  
22          Federated States of Micronesia during its October regular  
23          session each year until such time as all funds are fully  
24          expended."

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1       Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
3 law without such approval.

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
