CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 5-245, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To amend title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia by amending sections 101, 102, 103, 104, 105 and 107 and by adding a new section 108 to establish an Exclusive Economic Zone in the ocean surrounding the Federated States of Micronesia, to expand the size of the Territorial Sea, to make the chapter consistent with the current political status of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 101 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 101. Baseline system defined. A baseline is a continuous line which encircles an island or atoll. The 4 baseline from which the zones designated in this chapter are 5 6 to be measured is as follows:
 - (1) The baseline of an island or portion of an island lacking a barrier reef, fringing reef, or other reef system is the low-water line of the island as marked on large-scale charts officially recognized by the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 12 (2) The baseline of an atoll or island or portion of 13 an island having a barrier reef, fringing reef, or other 14 reef system is a line following the contour of the seaward 15 edge of the reef system, which line connects those 16 outermost elevations of the reef which are above water at 17 low tide, and which line exists as marked on large-scale 18 charts officially recognized by the Government of the 19 Federated States of Micronesia."
- 20 Section 2. Section 102 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 22 "Section 102. Territorial Sea and internal waters -

12	** 5	Section 103. Territorial Sea and internal waters -
13	Sc	overeignty. The sovereignty of the Federated States of
14	Mi	icronesia extends to its internal waters and Territorial
15	Se	ea, including sovereign rights over the living and
16	no	onliving resources in the Territorial Sea and internal
17	Wa	aters and in the airspace above the Territorial Sea and
18	ir	nternal waters as well as its bed and subsoil."
19	Section	n 4. Section 104 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated
20	States of Mi	icronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
21	*** (Section 104. Exclusive economic zone - Defined. There is
22	he	ereby established an exclusive economic zone contiguous
23	to	o the Territorial Sea. The inner boundary of the
24	ex	xclusive economic zone of each island or atoll is the
25	Se	eaward boundary of the Territorial Sea, and the outer

2	nautical miles seaward of the nearest point on the baseline
3	as defined in section 101 of this title."
4	Section 5. Section 105 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated
5	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
6	"Section 105. Exclusive economic zone - Regulation.
7	Within the exclusive economic zone, the National Government
8	of the Federated States of Micronesia shall have:
9	(1) Sovereign rights for the purpose of exploring and
10	exploiting, conserving and managing the natural resources,
11	whether living or nonliving, of the waters superjacent to
12	the seabed and of the seabed and its subsoil, and with
13	regard to other activities for the economic exploitation
14	and exploration of the zone;
15	(2) Jurisdiction with regard to the establishment and
16	use of artificial islands, installations, and structures;
17	marine scientific research; and the protection and
18	preservation of the marine environment; and
19	(3) Other rights and duties provided for in
20	international law."
21	Section 6. Section 107 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated
22	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
23	"Section 107. Regulations. The President of the Federated
24	States of Micronesia may issue such regulations as are
25	necessary to establish the boundaries of internal waters,

1	the Territorial Sea, and the exclusive economic zone."
2	Section 7. Chapter 1 of title 18 of the Code of the Federated
3	States of Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 108
4	to read as follows:
5	"Section 108. Definitions. As used in this chapter:
6	(1) 'Atoll' means a naturally formed reef system
7	which has one or more islands situated on the reef system,
8	including Ngulu, Ulithi, Sorol, Eauripik, Woleai, Faraulep,
9	Ifalik, Olaimarao, Elato, Lamotrek, West Fayu, Puluwat,
10	Pulap, Pulusuk, Namonuito, Kuop, Nomowin, Murilo, Losap,
11	Namoluk, Satawan, Etal, Lukunor, Minto Reef, Oroluk,
12	Nukuoro, Kapingamarangi, Pakin, Ant, Sapwuafik, Mwoakiloa,
13	and Pingelap.
14	(2) 'Island' means a naturally formed area of land,
15	surrounded by water, which is above water at high tide."
16	Section 8. This act shall become law upon approval by the
17	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
18	law without such approval.
