AN ACT TO AMEND THE RELIGIOUS BODIES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (CAP 89)

Commencement:

MADE by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by the Deretitenti.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Religious Bodies Registration (Amendment) Act 1985.

Amendment of section 2 of Cap 89.

- 2. Section 2 of the Religious Bodies Registration Ordinance (Cap 89) is amended in the definition of "Religious Body" by:
  - (i) repealing the words "50 persons of the age of 21" and substituting the following:

"2 per cont of persons of the age of 18 years"; and

(ii) inserting after "upwards" the following:

"as indicated in the latest report of
the Census Commissioner on the census
of the inhabitants of Kiribati taken
pursuant to the Census Ordinance (Cap 8)".

Savings

3. Nothing in this Act shall in any way affect or invalidate the registration of any religious body duly registered and made under the Religious Bodies Registration Ordinance (Cap 84) before the commencement of this Act.

## RELIGIOUS BODIES REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) ACT 1985

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. This Act amends section 2 of the Religious Bodies
  Registration Ordinance which defines a religious body as
  "any congregation society or body in Kiribati consisting
  of or representing not less than 50 persons of the age of
  21 years and upwards holding religious tenets in common
  and which has its own system of discipline and internal
  government".
- 2. The proposed amendment is contained in Clause 2 of the Act. It seeks to increase the number of the members of a religious body, before it can qualify to register as a religious body from the current number of 50 persons of the age of 21 years to 2 per cent of persons of the age of 18 years of the whole population of Kiribati as contained in the latest Kiribati Census Report of the Census Commissioner taken under the Census Ordinance.
- 3. All religious bodies which had been registered under the Religious Bodies Ordinance before the Commencement of the Act will not in any way be affected by this Act if it becomes law. This is contained in clause 3 of the Act.
