**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION OF  
MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR RECURRENT  
EXPENDITURE FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31  
DECEMBER 1995**

**MADE** by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by the Beretitenti.

**Short Title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1995.

**Authorisation of issue of \$1,440,788 from the Consolidated Fund**

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$1,440,788 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31 December 1995.

**Appropriation**

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.

## **SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT 1995**

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

- 1. This Act charged upon the Consolidated Fund a sum, which is required for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1995, in addition to the amount appropriated for that year by the Appropriation Act 1995.**
- 2. The sums required is to provide for money expended in excess of sums already appropriated.**
- 3. The Act provides that the additional amount charged shall be expended upon the service listed in the Schedule to the Act.**
- 4. The Act is presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of Section 109(3) of the Constitution.**
