If the offender in this case is a corporation or other legal entity, doing business in the Republic, the Secretary of Finance shall recommend to the appropriate Local Government, for the suspension of such entity's business license for a period of three months.

for a third offense, the penalty shall be a fine in an amount equal to double the value of the goods involved or one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), which ever is the greater amount, or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding twelve (12) months, or both. If the offender is a corporation or other legal entity doing business in the Republic, the Secretary of Finance shall recommend to the appropriate Local Government, for the permanent revocation of any such entity's business license.
