Facts

On December 2, 1980, at 1612 hours, police patrol in Boe forced off the road by a yellow sedan driven by the accused. Police officer took the keys and advised accused that he is being arrested for driving under the influence. He was found to be drunk with bloodshot eyes and unsteady on his feet.

Accused

Agree with the facts and to previous convictions

Court

1. Accused is convicted and is fined \$100 and his driving licence suspended for 8 months. Should he drive during the duration of the suspension to drive, he may be liable to imprisonment. Fine to be paid Friday April 10.
2. On the second charge of negligent driving, accused is convicted and fined \$50. Fine to be paid Friday April 10th.
