Act No.3 of 2010

An Act to amend the *Courts Act 1972*.

Certified on 1 November 2010

Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Courts (Amendment) Act 2010*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it receives the certificate of the Speaker under Article 47.

3 Act amended

The Schedule amends the *Courts Act 1972*.

A judge of the Supreme Court ceases to hold office on attaining the age of seventy-five years.

Note for section 5A


