

THE ISLAND OF NAURU.

A N O R D I N A N C E

To amend the Customs Tariff Amendment Ordinance 1922-1934.

I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru do hereby enact order and proclaim as under :

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Ordinance 1936 and shall be deemed to have come into operation as from 8 o'clock in the forenoon of the first day of January 1936.

2. The Customs Tariff Amendment Ordinance 1922-1934 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Ordinance 1922-1936.

4. By this Ordinance -

(a) The Schedule of import duties as embodied in the Principal Ordinance is cancelled and the following schedule substituted therefor:

1. Cigars	per lb.	3s.
2. Cigarettes	per 1,000	10s.
3. Tobacco and all tobacco manu- factures not elsewhere included	per lb.	2s.
4. Spirits, schnapps and liqueurs of all kinds - (i) not exceeding the strength of proof	per gallon	14s.
(ii) exceeding the strength of proof	per proof gallon.	14s.
5. Wines - still and sparkling, including medicated wines and vermouth	per gallon	5s.
6. Ale, stout and other beer, spirituous	"	1s. 6d.
7. Cider and Perry, spirituous	"	1s. 3d.
8. Bicycle frames whether imported separately or as part of com- plete bicycle	each	10s.
9. Cylinder blocks for motor cycle engines whether imported separ- ately or as part of a complete motor cycle	each	12
10. Side cars for motor cycles	"	21
11. Bodies for motor cars whether imported separately or as part of a complete motor vehicle	"	25.
12. All other goods not included in the duty free list	ad. val.	10.

For the purposes of items 4 to 7 inclusive, heretofore specified -

- (a) Six reputed quarts or 12 reputed pints or 24 reputed half-pints shall be accepted as 1 gallon;
- (b) 'Spirits' means containing more than two per cent of proof spirit;
- (c) 'proof' or 'proof spirit' means spirit of a strength

equal to that of pure ethyl alcohol compounded with distilled water so that the resultant mixture at a temperature of 60° Fahrenheit has a specific gravity of 0.91976 as compared with that of distilled water at the same temperature."

(b) The Free List as embodied in the Principal Ordinance is amended as follows:-

(1) By the cancellation of Item 7 and the substitution of the following therefor.

"Item 7. Except where elsewhere specified, all machines and machinery including bicycles and motor vehicles, also component parts and accessories thereof."

(11) By the addition of the following items to be inserted after item 34 :

- "Item 35. Footwear to include boots shoes and slippers of whatever material manufactured.
- " 36. Bedsteads mattresses and all bedding including bolsters and pillows but not including bed linen.
- " 37. Cameras and all photographic materials and equipment.
- " 38. Electric Fans
- " 39 . Domestic Refrigerators and Ice Chests.
- " 40. Vacuum cleaners either hand or power operated."
