AN ORDINANCE

To amend the "Judiciary Ordinance 1922"

- I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :-
- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the "Judiciary Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1932" and shall come into operation forthwith.
- (2) The Judiciary Ordinance 1922 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Judiciary Ordinance 1922-1932.
- 2. The <u>Judiciary Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1928</u> is repealed.
- 3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the word "vested", the words "in the Administrator,".
- 4. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "the Administrator and/or".
- 5. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "the Administrator and".
- 6. Sub-section (2) of Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following subsection is inserted in its stead:-
 - " (2) Until Rules of Court are made in pursuance of this Section in relation to any particular matter, the Rules of Court of the Supreme Court of Queensland on that matter shall regulate the practice and procedure of the Central Court but shall cease to have any force or effect upon the making of Rules on that matter under this Section."
- 7. Section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section is inserted is its stead :-
 - " 17. An appeal to the Administrator shall lie from any judgment of the Central Court, and the Administrator may, after hearing the appeal, confirm, cancel or vary the judgment. The appeal shall be made in writing within four days from the date of the judgment, and shall set forth the grounds of appeal."
- 8. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "the Administrator and/or".
