

THE ISLAND OF NAURU

No. 6 of 1951.

AN ORDINANCE

To validate a certain agreement for lease.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between His Majesty's Government in London, His Majesty's Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and His Majesty's Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lands (Validating) Ordinance 1951*. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section three of the Lands Ordinance 1921-1950, the Agreement dated the eighth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine made between certain Nauruans and the British Phosphate Commissioners for the lease to the British Phosphate Commissioners of an area of land at Nauru containing 2 acres 2 roods 25.12 perches and approved by Harold Hastings Reeve, purporting to act as Acting Administrator of the Island of Nauru, is hereby declared to be, and at all times, to have been, valid and effectual. Validation of certain agreement for lease.
