THE REPUBLIC OF NAURU

PROCLAMATION

By the Council of
State for Nauru.

The Council of State, in pursuance of its powers under section 46 (g) of the Customs Ordinance 1921 of New Guinea, adopted as a law of the Republic,

- (a) revokes the proclamation made under that section by His Honour, the Acting Administrator of the Territory of Nauru, on the 24th day of May, 1965;
- (b) prohibits the import from New Zealand of pigs; and
- (c) prohibits the import from New Zealand of pigmeat, unless it is accompanied by a certificate from New Zealand government authorities verifying that it has been under deep freeze conditions for not less than 21 days before its export.
