## ENQUIRY INTO THE PUBLIC SERVICE

The Cabinet has appointed the Senior Administrative Officer, Mr. K.R.S. Miller, assisted by Mr. Ivan Dedogi, Staff Clerk, to conduct an enquiry into Public Service Administration on Nauru.

The aim of this enquiry is to lay the foundations for the future development of the Public Service in the light of the introduction of a Ministerial System of Government and the needs of an independent Republic.

The terms of reference provide for investigation and reports on:-

- (a) The classification structure and salary levels to be adopted in all departments of the Public Service, having regard to the need to integrate the salaries paid to Nauruan and overseas officers into one system of classification;
- (b) A scale of inducement allowances related to basic salaries which should be paid to officers recruited from overseas;
- (c) The organisation structure of each Department, having regard to Working Party proposals for the distribution of Public Service functions in the Republic;
- (d) Departmental working methods and procedures;
- (e) Conditions for appointment and advancement in the Public Service, penalty payments and other general conditions of service that may require revision or amendment;
- (f) The assessment and payment of overtime and H.D.A.;
- (g) In-service training for Nauruan staff.

The terms of reference give the investigators authority to make recommendations on any aspects Public Service Administration policy relevant to the terms of reference.
