THE CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ADAPTATION OF LAWS ORDER, 1969

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 6 of Article 85 of the Constitution of Nauru, I hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Adaptation of Laws Order, 1969.
2. Section 5 of the Interpretation Ordinance, 1956-1967 is adapted by the deletion of the words "'the Central Court" means the Central Court of the Island of Nauru" and by substituting therefore, but in the correct place by alphabetical order in the series of definitions, the words "'the Supreme Court" means the Supreme Court of Nauru established by Article 48 of the Constitution of Nauru".
3. The words "the Central Court", wherever they appear in any Ordinance, rule or regulation other than the Judiciary Ordinance 1957-1967 are deleted and the words "the Supreme Court" substituted therefore.
4. The adaptations specified in the last two preceding paragraphs shall be deemed to have had effect from the Thirty-first day of January, 1968.
