COMMISSION APPOINTING REGINALD SYLVESTER LEYDIN
A COMMISSIONER OF INQUIRY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

HIS EXCELLENCY HAMMER DEROBURT O.B.E. PRESIDENT OF THE
REPUBLIC OF NAURU FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CABINET

GREETING:

WHEREAS the Parliament of the Republic of Nauru has resolved that the Government of the Republic appoint a Commission consisting of one or more Commissioners to enquire into -

- (1) whether the terms of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1968 are adequate in respect of
 - (a) The President
 - (b) The Ministers
 - (c) The Speaker and Deputy Speaker; and
 - (d) The Members of Parliament, and also
- (2) whether additional remuneration should be paid to a Minister for the time being performing the functions of the President during the President's incapacity or absence from the Island;

AND WHEREAS the Cabinet, upon considering such an inquiry to be for the public welfare and bearing in mind the confidence which it holds in Reginald Sylvester Leydin C.B.E., desires to appoint him as Commissioner under the provisions of the Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance 1948-1967 to inquire into those matters and to report to it thereon.

NOW THEREFORE THE CABINET HEREBY APPOINTES YOU, THE SAID
REGINALD SYLVESTER LEYDIN C.B.E.

As COMMISSIONER pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance 1948-1967 and authorises him to inquire into the matters hereinbefore mentioned;

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have caused the Seal of the Cabinet to be affixed in prusance of its decision, this Ninth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and seventy.
